

Creekside Park

Creekside Park is located at 1821 Old Airport Road, New Bern, NC 28560 adjacent to Craven Regional Airport. Creekside is comprised of 111 acres, which opened in 1997. It has become host to various sports leagues such as Coastal United Soccer Assoc., NB Babe Ruth Girls Softball, NB Sunday School Baseball, youth football, Adult Co-ed Softball, Men's Softball, Co-ed Kickball, Senior Softball and Special Needs Baseball.

- Three adult softball fields
- One adult baseball field
- Eight sand volleyball courts
- 18 hole disc golf course
- Three Tennis courts

West Craven Park

West Craven Park is located at 2791 Streets Ferry Road, Vanceboro, NC 28586 across from West Craven High School. WC Park is comprised of 91 acres, which opened in 2008. This park is home to West Craven Little League Baseball and West Craven Pop Warner Youth Football. We also host practices, tournaments, games and matches for other youth organizations such as the Craven Jaguars AYFL, West Craven High School Soccer and Tennis teams.

Latham-Whitehurst Nature Park



Craven County's Latham-Whitehurst Nature Park is located at 1095 Broad Creek Road, New Bern, NC 28560 near Fairfield Harbour. The Nature Park opened

in 2011 and is comprised of 133 acres of preserved pristine coastal land.

This is Craven County's first nature park, which is geared towards the natural environment as it will offer hiking, nature observation, bird watching, and access to Broad Creek by way of a boardwalk. Approximately one mile north from Lee's Landing.

- Extensive gravel walking trail
- Other extensive natural walking trail systems
- 2,000 ft. boardwalk that will allow:
 - Nature observation
 - Fishing
 - Canoe, kayak and boat docking
- Picnic tables throughout
- Restroom facilities
