The Neuse River Senior Games is returning for its **41st** year promoting health, fun, fitness and friendship for Seniors **50** years and better! The Steering Committee has been working hard to ensure a great 2026 Neuse River Senior Games & SilverArts Competition experience! Please take a moment to carefully read the information below as it includes important information, dates, and announcements.

- Registration for the 2026 Neuse River Senior Games will begin on Sunday, February 1. Register online at ncseniorgames.org/neuse.
- The 2026 registration fee will be **\$15.00** for **Early Bird Registration** and **\$20** for **Regular Registration**.
- **Registration will end on Monday, March 16.** Late registration will NOT be available; don't wait until the last minute!
- **Cycling will be held on Tuesday, April 21** at the Carteret County Speedway. Cyclists will compete alongside participants from the Carteret County Senior Games and the Onslow County Senior Games.
- **Pickleball will be held outdoors at Creekside Park** on Monday, April 27 (Mixed Doubles) and Tuesday, April 28 (Singles & Doubles). Singles will be held in the morning and Doubles will be held in the afternoon. The rain plan for Pickleball will be to play at Stanley White Recreation Center.
- **Individual start times for tournament events will be sent to participants approximately a week prior to their scheduled event.**
- The SilverArts Competition will be held **in-person** at the Craven County Senior Center. A message will be sent out to participants closer to the competition date with more information.
- **Awards will not be distributed at individual events.** Awards will be presented at the Celebration of Games Closing Ceremonies and will be available for pickup at 1821 Old Airport Rd., New Bern, NC 28562 starting Friday, May 15.

The Celebration of Games Closing Ceremonies will be held at the Twin Rivers YMCA on Thursday, May 14 at 5:00pm. **On page 5, please indicate your attendance at the Celebration of Games Closing Ceremonies and dinner immediately following.**

If you will be participating in or observing an outdoor event, please bring sunscreen, chairs, etc. to the event for your comfort. Please feel free to invite your family and friends! SilverArts General Information

- Artists may not enter a piece of art if that piece has previously been entered at State Finals.
- Literary entries **must** be mailed with the entry form.
- Registration deadline for SilverArts is the same as for all other components of the Neuse River Senior Games.
- Silver Artists may enter a maximum of one item in each sub-category.
- "Grouped sets" in Visual and Heritage Arts may have no more than 3 members. An example of a "grouped set" would be China Painting: plate, cup, saucer OR Jewelry: necklace & earrings.

The Neuse River Senior Games and the North Carolina Senior Games State Finals have the right to refuse or remove any or all entries that are deemed obnoxious or repulsive in character.



At present, SilverArts recognizes four broad categories, each with several sub-categories. First and second place winners in the Literary subcategory will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. First, second and third place winners in the Visual and Heritage sub-categories will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. North Carolina Senior Games Finals awards first, second and third place in each sub-category of these arts.

One overall winner in the Performing Arts category will also be eligible for the North Carolina Senior Games Finals and be able to compete for first, second and third place awards. **The Neuse River Senior Games awards first, second, and third place in all the sub-categories.**

Guidelines

- All persons entering SilverArts must be 50 years of age or better and registered as a Neuse River Senior Games participant.
- Entries must be original works of the artist, must be a work created after the artist is age 50 or better, and must have been completed within **two years** of the Neuse River Senior Games registration deadline.
- **Complete SilverArts information is available at www.ncseniorgames.org**

Visual Arts (Must have been completed within the last 2 years)

- All artwork, except sculptures, must be clearly framed, wired (no serrated hooks or strings), and ready to be hung. **Artwork not properly framed & wired will not be displayed.**
- Artwork can be no larger than 36" x 42", including matting and frame. Sculptures can be no heavier than 15 pounds, and must be able to be displayed in a 3' x 3' area.
- Master studies are accepted.
- The art piece must be an original work, not print, and the artist's name and title of entry must appear on or be attached to the entry for identification.
- The artist must send a photograph of the entry with the State Finals Entry Form and SilverArts Information Form when entering State Finals.

Literary Arts (Must have been completed within the last 2 years)

- Poems can be no longer than 40 lines.
- Short stories (fiction), essays (not autobiographical), articles, life experiences can be no longer than 8 pages, double-spaced, with a 1" margin on all sides. Entries must have a title page which includes the title of the work, sub-category, and artist name.
- **A display quality copy of the entry and 3 additional copies must be submitted with the registration form.**

Performing Arts (Must have been completed within the last 2 years)

- Performing entries are limited to 3 minutes of on-stage time.
- Performing entries may be one of the following: soloists with accompanists, small groups of 2-4 performers, or large groups of 5 or more performers.
- Performers must provide a USB thumb drive for performances with music tagged at the beginning of the video. Props are the responsibility of the performer.
- Performers wanting introductory material given prior to their performance are responsible for preparing it. Such material should be given to the SilverArts Coordinator for delivery to the Master of Ceremonies.
- Voice presentations must be performed live (lip-synch is not permitted) and background music must be taped.
- Instructors and/or group members under age 50 will not be permitted to perform on stage with the group at local or state games.

Heritage Arts (Must have been completed within the last 2 years)

- Heritage arts entries must be original works and the work of the individual and not a group effort.

Registration Fees

A registration fee of \$15.00 (Early Bird) or \$20 (Regular) is required from all participants registering by **Monday, March 16**. Some activities will require extra fees (*this is indicated on the registration form*), which should be submitted in addition to the registration fee. **All fees must accompany the registration/waiver form for the participant to be eligible.** The registration fee includes a Neuse River Senior Games t-shirt as well as a dinner meal at the Celebration of Games Closing Ceremonies.

A limited number of Registration Fee Waivers are available. A waiver is the base \$15.00 fee. To request and be considered for a waiver, please check the line on the first page of the Registration Form.

No registration will be accepted after Monday, March 16 at 5:00pm

ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE

Due to the strenuous nature of the athletic events, it is recommended that you consult your physician prior to beginning training for the actual competition.

A participant must be a North Carolina resident for a minimum of 3 consecutive months of the year.

Only persons who are 50 years of age or better by December 31, 2026 and residents of the six sponsoring counties (**Craven, Duplin, Greene, Jones, Lenoir, and Pamlico**) are eligible to participate in the Neuse River Senior Games.

General Information

Participants must complete the official registration form with a signature, inclusive of medical information and physicians phone number. The liability waiver must be signed and the “fees” section of the registration form must be completed.

Confirmation: Shortly after registration closes in March, you will receive a letter confirming your events with times and locations listed. If you believe the confirmation is incorrect, please call (252) 636-6606 to verify.

Athletic Awards: In Athletic Events, Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded to the top three finishers in each age category, for males and females. Awards will be distributed at the Celebration of Games Closing Ceremonies (they will not be distributed at each individual event) or available for pick up at the Craven County Recreation and Parks office located at 1821 Old Airport Road, New Bern, NC starting Friday, May 15.

SilverArts Awards: First, second, & third place winners in **Visual and Heritage Arts** will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. First & second place winners in the **Literary sub-category** will be eligible for the NC Senior Games Finals. However, North Carolina Senior Games Finals awards first, second, and third place in each sub-category of these arts.

Athletic Events

Please indicate the events you wish to enter on the registration form. You may enter all the events you wish, but if two events overlap or are scheduled at the same time, it is up to you to meet the games requirements for those events.

Tournament events require you to report at the time listed. Tournament events are indicated with an asterisk (*). **Open** events allow you to report at any time during the time period listed.

Where a time conflict exists between tournament and open events, you must report to the tournament event first and participate **prior** to moving on to the open event. **Failure to do so will result in disqualification.**

State Finals Entry Forms: DO NOT MAIL BEFORE MAY 31, 2026! The State Finals entry form must be received in Raleigh at the NC Senior Games Office no later than 11:59 p.m. on August 1, 2026.

Your age as of December 31, 2026 determines the category in which you will be placed for competition. Participants compete against others of their own sex and age as follows:
